

RULES AND CONDITIONS

1. All entries on official forms to the Cricket Pavilion, Ibstone between 6.30 and 8.00 pm on Tuesday 2nd August or Wednesday 3rd August. Postal entries should be addressed to Mr. M. Smith, The Brambles, Ibstone, Bucks. HP14 3XZ. NO ENTRIES WILL BE ACCEPTED AFTER 8.00 PM ON WEDNESDAY 3rd August.
2. All entries to be grown or made by the exhibitor except in Classes 15, 16, 44, 93, 96 and 100.
3. Novice Cup: A novice is a competitor of any age, resident in Ibstone, who has not won first prize in Sections A, B, C or D in the previous three years.
4. Ornamental fruits, berries and leaves are allowed in classes 15, 16 and 44.
5. Entries for the Art Classes must be original work only.
6. Domestic Classes are judged in line with the Women's Institute Guide for Exhibitors and Judges.
7. Handicraft Exhibits must have been made within the previous three years. No exhibit accepted from previous years entries.
8. Wine Exhibits - All wine exhibits must have been produced solely by the Exhibitor by the normal process of fermentation and must not be fortified with the addition of alcohol. All wine entries are to be exhibited in clear glass, punted or semi-punted, bottles of 26 fluid oz. capacity fitted with white plastic topped flanged corks. NOTE: These corks are normally available from "Boots" Chemists. All wine entries are to be labelled with the standard white pre-gummed wine label. The level of wine in each bottle should be between 12 and 25mm from the bottom of the fitted cork.
9. If there are fewer than 6 entries or entries are not up to standard in any one class, prizes may be withheld by the Judges, whose decision is final.
10. Exhibits to be staged between 8.00 am and 10.00 am on the day of the Show. Exhibits and cards must remain until 4.15 pm; those not removed by 4.45 pm, or not indicated 'not for sale', will be sold by auction.
11. Prize money to be collected from Cricket Pavilion between 2.30pm - 3.30pm
12. While all reasonable care will be taken, the Committee will not be liable for any loss or damage which may occur.
13. An exhibitor may stage more than one exhibit in any class. One prize only in any class to one exhibitor. Points awarded: 3 for 1st prize, 2 for 2nd, 1 for 3rd. In the event of a tie, the exhibitor with the most 1st prizes wins the Cup.
14. All entries in the PHOTOGRAPHIC CLASSES must have been taken by the exhibitor, but may have been processed professionally. Entries must be prints, either colour or black and white. Prints must not exceed 250mm x 200mm in size excluding mounts (if any). NAME AND ADDRESS PRINTED ON REVERSE. No more than three entries from one person in any one class.
15. Where any age limit is specified, the exhibitor's age on the 1st August 2011 is applicable.
